6 問題 (17): 次の英文を読んで、質問の答えとして最も正しいものを一つ選びなさい。

Researchers in Japan say their study of coffee intake suggests that drinking coffee likely lowers the risk of death from disease. They surveyed over 90,000 men and women between the ages of 40 and 69 about their coffee drinking habits. The researchers then tracked their mortality rate for an average of 19 years. Researchers say those who drank one to two cups of coffee a day had a 15 percent lower risk than who consumed little or no coffee. The risk for those who drank three to four cups a day was 24 percent lower.

The researchers say similar study on green tea consumption showed it may also reduce the risk. They also say caffeine and some other ingredients in the drinks may be responsible for lowering the risk.

Question: What do the researchers say about coffee drinking?

- ① That drinking coffee likely raises the risk of death from disease.
- ② That those who drank one to two cups of coffee a day had a 24 percent lower risk than those who had little or no coffee.
